PRAYERS

CARES started a **new soup ministry** delivered to members recovering from illness or surgery. We also continue with our **prayer chain** ministry, **card ministry**, and **visitations**. Because we are called to **pray ceaselessly**, it can be difficult to quantify this discipleship practice, but you can hear more about our CARES ministry on the back of this report.

PRESENCE



25 women attending the Fall Women's Bible Study.

19 men attended the Men's Ministry Dinner in August.

9 families, including 14 children, attended the Family Zoo Outing.

100 people attended the Back to School dinner.

58 seats at the table were filled for our Break Bread Together meals.

On an average Sunday, we have present **95 disciples** in Sunday School, **139 in-person** worshippers, and **57 online** worshippers.



GIFTS

\$165,689.43 in tithes, gifts, and offerings given to God through Open Hearts UMC, which is an **8.2% increase** from last quarter.

5 new choristers joined the adult choir to share their gifts in worship.

382 hours from volunteers who shared their gifts for our music ministry.



SERVICE

7 servants spent 6 days at Salkehatchie repairing 2 homes in Newberry.

50 backpacks filled with school supplies were donated to Southside High School.

167 items were given to the teachers at Grove and Thomas Kerns Elementary Schools.

9 people packed approximately 1600 meals for Meals on Wheels.

17 people served as hosts to our 9 Break Bread Together meals in September.



WITNESS

8 individuals delivered cold treats to the Salkehatchie team and home owners at the Newberry work site.

16 individuals donated blood, saving up to 48 lives through The Blood Connection.

6 youth led the congregation in a powerful worship Youth Sunday service and gave witness to their work at Salkehatchie.

20,300 people reached on Facebook, which is 141% increase from last quarter, and 1054 new visitors to our website.

Important Children's Ministry Update



We've reviewed the metrics for when families with children are most engaged in the life of the church, and while few attend during the Sunday School hour program, we consistently have a large number of children present for worship at 11:00 am.

In an effort to better serve them with a quality program, we will be offering their program following the Children's Message, previously known as Children's Church. We're calling it "Sunday Bible School", because it will combine fun aspects of Vacation Bible School with a UMC curriculum curated by Jana Clack. It is our hope to have two classes weekly, one for ages 4–6 & one for ages 7–11. This will mean having 3–4 volunteers weekly who will assist with the program that will support the discipleship of our youngest church–goers. *Sunday Bible School will replace the Sunday School model at 9:45 am. During that time, children will be dropped off in room B–4 near the Welcome Center for Pray and Play.*

Resources and activities are provided by Jana Clack, who is available each Sunday to volunteers as well. If you are interested in serving every 6 weeks or so, sign up to volunteer **here**.


First Friday Coffee
