May 11 - We celebrate and confirm Open Hearts UMC's first Confirmation class in worship.


May 18 – We celebrate and recognize our graduates in worship, as well as new members joining.

- That today Epworth offers a multitude of services, including recruiting and licensing foster families throughout South Carolina, kinship care for grandparents and others raising another person's child, an Early Intervention Center to serve families with special needs, intensive in-home services, parent support groups, and a program to prepare those 18-23 for higher education and pursuit of careers?
- That Epworth Children's Home in Columbia provides youth 12–18 residential care, including 24-hour/7 days a week adult support, counseling, tutoring, and healthcare?
- That Open Hearts has an Epworth office in our church?

We welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem on Palm Sunday waving branches and remembered His sacrifice on Maundy Thursday through a




