

Celebrating Stewardship

JANUARY - MARCH 2025



PRAYERS

- **24 quarts of soup delivered** for people on our prayer list who were sick.
- **74 new prayer requests** received and prayed for by our CARES team.
- **86 inspirational cards and valentines** written and sent to church members in need and delivered to 6 local agencies.
- **114 cards** mailed and **68 birthday cards** sent to members.



PRESENCE

- 30 women attended the Spring Women's Bible Study.
- **30 ladies** participated in the Galentine's dinner.
- **92 participants** at our Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper, hosted by our men.
- **6 youth and leaders** attended the UMC weekend retreat, Revolution 2025.
- **16 men** attended the quarterly Men's Ministry Night Out dinner.
- On an average Sunday, we have present **94 disciples** in Sunday School, **154 in-person** worshippers, and **63 online** worshippers.



GIFTS

- **\$1,250 contributed** to The Julie Valentine Center from OHUMC, increased by individual contributions from members.
- **\$2,000 contributed** by the Open Hearts Sunday School class to **6 local charities**.
- **\$268,550** in tithes, gifts, and offerings given to God through Open Hearts UMC, which is a **2.9%** increase from last quarter.



SERVICE

- 11 members helped pack approximately 2000 meals at Meals on Wheels.
- **5 volunteers** prepared a meal for **12 young women** involved with GirlUp GVL.
- **65 members and community guests** attended our educational presentation and dinner focused on poverty and homelessness in our community.
- **492 hours** from volunteers serving in music ministry and **83 hours** from volunteers serving in audio/visual ministry.



WITNESS

- **12 adults and 6 children** were added to our membership.
- **18 individuals** donated blood, saving up to **54 lives** through The Blood Connection.
- 17.6K people reached on Facebook with 50 new follows, which is up 61%,
- **3 members** were affirmed for ordained ministry at called charge conference.
- **18 new and prospective members** attended the Coffee with Karen gatherings, held the first Sunday of each month.



At Open Hearts United Methodist Church, **stewardship is discipleship**. When you give to God your **prayers**, **presence**, **gifts**, **service**, **and witness**, you live into the call of being a disciple of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.
