



"HOLY CURIOSITY" SERMONS

7/6 Christian Influence in Challenging Times

"... How may we be a persuasive influence that modifies and transforms our world, city, and church to be better followers of Jesus Christ?"
"...how to reach across the table in a divided America (or just find your own peace)...being upset/frustrated/dismayed with the Far Right and its hold on 'Christian Values.' How do we find discernment in when to hold each other accountable, having hard conversations, and when to let those relationships go."

7/13 Sexuality (Preached in tandem with Rev. Hillary Taylor)

"...would I still be welcomed to Heaven or condemned to Hell [for loving gay family member just the way they are.]"

Are bi, trans, gays in leadership roles allowed, and "...how does [their leadership] affect others in our community of faith?"

7/20 God and Gender

"What are some feminine images of God in the Bible? Why do we portray God as a man/father, and what could we gain from more diverse views of God?"

7/27 Heaven and Angels

"How will [deceased husband] know he will recognize me when I get [to heaven]?"

"... I also have questions about angels, and what we know about heaven from Scripture."

"Can loved ones communicate with us after they've passed? Does the Bible address ghosts/apparitions coming back to earth to visit?"

8/3 Judgment and Salvation

"What will happen to my loved ones who are not saved or who have fallen asleep in their faith? Jews, atheists, former Christians, etc.?"
"...if someone is raised in a culture that never introduces them to Christ, are they denied access to heaven? Or, if they are practicing Jews, love and serve the Lord in all the ways, they, too, go to hell?"
"In hell, do people burn to death, or is hell more a place without access to God?"
